Wednesday Bible Study: Notes, and an Application from Romans 1

Jesus Christ our Lord is the Son of God, so declared powerfully by the resurrection from the dead. But in the flesh he was the son (seed) of David. (1:1-4).

Paul's apostleship was given to him so that all nations could exercise obedient faith. Among the nations, the Romans were a part of those who had heard and heeded "the call of the gospel".(see also 2 Thess. 2:14.)

Romans 1:9 is a good example of what is meant by the admonition, "Pray without ceasing".

Because Paul and the Romans had a shared (mutual) faith, he could expect to comfort them and be comforted in return (1:12) Paul wanted to make the journey to Rome for the purpose of imparting a spiritual gift for their strengthening, but also to "have some fruit" among them. He had "had fruit" among other Gentile people 1:10-13). He felt indebted to preach to Greeks, Barbarians (foreigners),wis, and unwise, but his chief aim as he writes is to preach at Rome.

In this section there are three expressions of "I am" from the pen of Paul:

1. I am debtor (to preach to "all")

2. I am ready to preach to you Romans also.

3. I am not ashamed of the gospel.

The gospel is God's power to save believers, whether Jew or Greek.

Two things are revealed about God: The gospel reveals the righteousness of God. The wrath of God is revealed from heaven

against ungodliness and unrighteousness.

Unrighteous men have seen evidence of God. He has shown them the evidence. They have SEEN the INVISIBLE THINGS of God in his creation, evidence of His eternal power and deity. Unrighteous men are without excuse when they KNOW God but refuse to glorify and thank Him

Vain men, in spiritually darkened hearts, claim wisdom and become fools as they create gods in the image of humans and animals.

When people give up the true Creator (God) for the created gods of the world, God gives

them over to their own depraved lusts. Those desires manifest themselves with both men and women leaving the natural relationship that God established for marriage, and burning in their unnatural lusts, practices that are "unseemly" and "against nature".

The refusal to keep God in "their knowledge" created a new way of thinking, a reprobate mind to do all kinds of wicked things which are described as "worthy of death".

Many people who KNOW the judgment of God, still persist in doing these vile things and have pleasure in others who live in the same way.

It is discouraging to see our society bombarded by the heathenish propaganda of the world. Our youth buy into the materialistic and hedonistic lifestyle. Parents look on with wonderment but an apparent helplessness to do or say anything to hinder the downward slide toward hell.

"Adult" children of today lament to one another: "I'm bored, text me". "I don't see any purpose in life". Why do I lie here and can't go to sleep?" "I may not be here tomorrow". "My life is my music". and other expressions that I cannot quote here because of the gross indecency of language that is used to express many desperate lifestyles. "Whoso loveth instruction loveth knowledge:but he that hateth reproof is

brutish." Prov. 12:1

He that refuseth instruction despiseth his own soul: but he that heareth reproof getteth understanding." Prov. 15:32
