The New Testament records no sermons of Andrew. No accounts of his missionary journeys are given. We have no record of his writings. As far as history is concerned, his outstanding accomplishment was that he brought his brother to Jesus. He set an example of personal evangelism that warms the heart of all Bible students.

His example should inspire us to go out in search of those whom God has placed in our reach. They may be brothers, friends, schoolmates, or business associates.

One of the greatest needs of the church today is more Andrews. There is someone waiting just for you to bring him unto Jesus. It is altogether possible that there are souls who will never be brought to Him unless they are brought by you. Have you done anything about it?
