About half of the workers, including those from Tennessee were delayed leaving Nashville because of storms in Atlanta and barely missed (by 2 minutes) their connecting flight Friday night from Atlanta to Santiago. They waited almost 24 hours for the next flight Saturday night. The workers who had flights which made the connection are waiting until the rest of the group arrives Sunday morning, then they will travel 7 more hours by bus to Lota.
