He worked with the youth there full time for several years, and his example of unselfish service inspired many of the young people there to be active servants in the church.

After he and Angel discovered that they were going to be parents, Angel gave up her work as a speech therapist to be a full-time mother, and John returned to his business as a tree trimmer/remover. Only three months after Tyler was born, John was almost killed by a heavy limb which bounced into his head and crushed his skull. Through many prayers and the support of Christian friends he was able to recover. Several men of the Mt. Juliet church helped keep his business going until he could get back to work.

He still experiences excruciating headaches at times, and due to back pain he has sold his bucket truck and chipper. However he continues to work outside grinding stumps and doing occasional saw work. His recovery is a story in courage and solid work ethic. He loves other people, and even more he loves the Lord, taking every opportunity to serve in his community and even in foreign mission fields. It makes me grateful to be able to call him Son.

6. What priest anointed the third king of Israel?

8. How are anointing and the Holy Spirit connected?
9. Who anointed a tent with oil?

Answers for September 18

Matthew 27:33 says “Golgotha” means, place of a skull. But could you go the other way? **Find the proper names, places, or Bible phrases that have the following meanings:**

1. King of peace

Answer: Salem (Heb. 7:3)

Hebrews 6:20 Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. 7:1 For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him; 2 To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem,

which is, King of peace; 3 Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the Son of God; abideth a priest continually.

2. Sorcerer

Answer: Elymas Acts 13:8

Acts 13:6 And when they had gone through the isle unto Paphos, they found a certain sorcerer, a false prophet, a Jew, whose name was Barjesus:7 Which was with the deputy of the country, Sergius Paulus, a prudent man; who called for Barnabas and Saul, and desired to hear the word of God.8 But Elymas the sorcerer (for so is his name by interpretation) withstood them, seeking to turn away the deputy from the faith.9 Then Saul, (who also is called Paul,) filled with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him,10 And said, O full of all subtlety and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord? 11 And now, behold, the hand of the Lord is upon thee, and thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season. And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand. 12 Then the deputy, when he saw what was done, believed, being astonished at the doctrine of the Lord.

3. Sent

Answer: Siloam (John 9:7)

John 9:1 And as Jesus passed by, he saw a man which was blind from his birth. 2 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.4 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay, 7 And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

4. Confusion

Answer: Babel Gen. 11:9

Gen 11:1-9 KJV) And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech. {2} And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; and they dwelt there. {3} And they said one to another, Go to, let us make brick, and burn them thoroughly. And they had brick for stone, and slime had they for mortar. {4} And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth. {5} And the LORD came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men builded. {6} And the LORD said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do. {7} Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech. {8} So the LORD scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city. {9} Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the LORD scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.

5. Burning

Answer: Taberah (Numbers 11:3)

Numbers 11:1 And when the people complained, it displeased the LORD: and the

LORD heard it; and his anger was kindled; and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed them that were in the uttermost parts of the camp. 2 And the people cried unto Moses; and when Moses prayed unto the LORD, the fire was quenched. 3 And he called the name of the place Taberah: because the fire of the LORD burnt among them.

6. Red

Answer: Esau, Edom

1: Genesis 25:25 And the first came out red, all over like an hairy garment; and they called his name Esau. Genesis 25:30 And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same red pottage; for I am faint: therefore was his name called Edom. Genesis 32:3 ¶And Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his brother unto the land of Seir, the country of Edom.

7. Be opened

Answer: Ephphatha Mark 7:34

Mark 7:31 And again, departing from the coasts of Tyre and Sidon, he came unto the sea of Galilee, through the midst of the coasts of Decapolis. 32 And they bring unto him one that was deaf, and had an impediment in his speech; and they beseech him to put his hand upon him.33 And he took him aside from the multitude, and put his fingers into his ears, and he spit, and touched his tongue; 34 And looking up to heaven, he sighed, and saith unto him, Ephphatha, that is, Be opened. 35 And straightway his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spake plain.

8. Son of encouragement

Answer: Barnabas (the encourager)

Acts 4:36 And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, (which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,) a Levite, and of the country of Cyprus . . .
